MICKY BASSI ACHIEVES IMPRESSIVE REPEAT

WIN IN THE TOTAL EXCELLIUM ECONOMY RUN

Driving his 1989 Alfa 75 fuel injection saloon Micky Bassi achieved an impressive repeat win in the Total Excellium Economy Run. He used only 2.54 litres of petrol to cover the 94 kms route giving him an outstanding fuel consumption of 37 kms per litre.

Renowned Concours d'Elegance competitor Sati Gata Aura finished a worthy second in a two litre Alfa GTV sports coupe made in 1973. This carburettor engined car was the oldest machine in the annual event and consumed five litres of fuel beating the results of several competitors in newer cars with fuel injection engines.

Shyam Soni who joined the Alfa Romeo Owners Club recently finished third driving an Alfa 156 saloon equipped with a 1800 cc fuel injection engine. He beat seasoned competitors including the club Chairman Peter Wanday who drove an identical car. In addition to his podium place, Shyam had the satisfaction of winning the 1800 cc class.

After presenting Micky Bassi with the Beppe Scarpellini memorial trophy and an armful of prizes, Lillian Gakunju, the Communications Coordinator of Total Kenya, complimented the Alfa Romeo Owners Club for

holding the annual Economy Run since 1982 to promote road safety. She congratulated Micky for demonstrating the benefits of using Total Excellium petrol and driving steadily within speed limits.

Five time winner Shailesh Chandaria was placed fourth overall and captured the prize for the 1800 cc carburettor class in his 1982 Giulietta which appears regularly at the Nairobi Racecourse during the Concours d'Elegance.

Making his first appearance in the Economy Run for several years Gayling May won the 1600 cc fuel injection class in his Alfa 147. He crowned his day with first place for road cars in the car care competition. In addition to taking home the top prizes for the Economy Run Micky Bassi earned the award for the best kept Concours car.
